Cq net, cq net, this is (*call sign*) and my name is (*name*). Good evening and welcome to the Boone County Amateur Radio Association net, I will be your net control operator for this evening. This is a directed net, please don't break the net unless you have any emergency or priority traffic. This net meets each Thursday at 8:00 pm. The purpose of this net is to exchange information pertaining to amateur radio, traffic handling, BCARA club activities, and to encourage 2 meter activity in the Boone County and central Indiana area. You do not need to be associated with the BCARA to check-in, all stations are welcome to check-in. For this net we are using the N9HLL repeater located in Lebanon, Indiana. The repeater operates with a PL tone of 77.00 hz. We would also like to thank Rick, N9HLL for the use of this repeater for the net. If the repeater should fail, we will meet on 146.500 simplex.

Before we begin, is there any emergency or priority traffic? Please call now, this is (*call sign*).

Hearing none, I will now go over the list of up coming BCARA activities and any other activities worth mentioning.
